The Commission for the Protection of Competition cleared the concentration of the companies DHL Worldwide Express B.V. και DHL (Cyprus) Ltd

On the 23rd of February 2005, the Service of the Commission for the Protection of Competition, received a notification of a proposed concentration according to Article 13 of the Control of Concentration between Enterprises Law 22(I)/99.

With this notification, DHL Worldwide Express B.V who owns 49% of the share capital of DHL (Cyprus) Ltd and DHL (Cyprus) Ltd, informed the Service of the Commission for the Protection of Competition that on the 23rd of February 2005, they have signed an agreement by which DHL Worldwide Express B.V will acquire the remaining 51% of the share capital of DHL (Cyprus) Ltd.

The Service of the C.P.C., on the 24th of March 2005, after evaluating the information notified by the companies according to schedule III of the Law 22(I)/99, prepared a preliminary report that was presented to the Commission.

The C.P.C, taking into consideration the above information, unanimously decided, on the basis of section 18 of the Law 22(I)/99, to declare the concentration compatible with the competitive market.
